## **Careers: Year 11 September Offer**

Year 11 Students have been set as a Homework on Go 4 Schools (G4S) a short MS form to complete regarding the offer they have received for their next step post GCSE/ Btec exams. It is a statutory requirement that we collate the *Year 11 September Offer* information by the Department of Education. The offer a student has received may be dependent on students achieving certain grades or it may be an unconditional offer.

Students who have multiple offers are only required to report **one offer** and therefore input the information for the offer they would most like to take up in September 2024. Students can change their minds at any point but **are not** required to report this so do not need to complete the Microsoft form again.

Some students may not know at this stage what they want to do next and may not make a decision about their destination until after they receive their results in August so do not have to report their next step. NLS, and our local Prospects Careers Service, can support those students who are struggling to decide what it is they would like to do next and help ensure that all our young people have a positive destination post 16.

We would appreciate parents and carers support by ensuring their child completes the MS Form if they have received an offer or, complete the form, as soon as they receive an offer between now and July. The link to the form is [here](#).
