## Year 11 Spanish Curriculum Overview

### Rationale for Year group & skills:

In Spanish students will undertake 5 lessons per fortnight. The Year 11 curriculum is designed to develop confidence and provide skills, such as; communication, teamwork and resilience. Students continue to be curious about the language and be respectful and tolerant of the differences in culture in Spanish-speaking countries. Language learning is a positive and rewarding experience, relevant to the needs of each student. Lessons incorporate the four skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. The topics studied environment, charity and volunteering work, jobs, careers, family, relationships, leisure and free time and festivals.

Students will develop grammatical rules, including; modal verbs in different tenses, reinforcement of the difference between por and para.

#### Skills:

In every lesson, students develop their speaking, reading, listening and writing skills.

Students will understand the criteria for the roleplay and photo card sections of the speaking exam. They will also develop spontaneous speech for the conversation section.

Students will continue to understand target grade structures needed for written work and develop translation skills, English into Spanish.

#### Wider experiences:

Students will understand the world of work and the value of languages.

Students will also continue with CIAG – careers in MFL.

They will complete a research project on careers and job adverts.

GCSE topics from a past reading and listening paper. They will be assessed on their knowledge of vocabulary, grammar and translation.

#### Writing exams

Foundation tier – a photo card task, a 40 word task, a translation of five sentences and a 90 word task.

Higher tier – a 90 word task, a 150 word task and a small paragraph to translate. (3 topics)

# Spring / Summer (10 weeks)

## Topic 3: Family and relationships; leisure and free time

#### Knowledge:

Students will use prior characteristic adjectives and develop new descriptions by adding comparatives, superlatives and relative clauses. They will discuss relationships with family and friends, focusing on the present tense with reflexive and modal verbs. The past tense and future tense will be reinforced to enable students to discuss past and future family plans.

Students will also discuss activities they do with friends and / or family; using a range of vocabulary to discuss their leisure / free time.

#### Skills:

In every lesson, students develop their speaking, reading, listening and writing skills.

They will understand the exam criteria for Foundation and Higher tier in each assessment. Students will develop an understanding of distractors and strategies for listening and reading. For speaking, they will learn key phrases for the role-play, form questions and develop answers for the photo card as well as be confident with tense formation.

Translation skills from both Spanish into English and English into Spanish will be reinforced.

#### Wider experiences:

#### Assessment:

- Students will complete a writing exam question either a 90 or a 150 word task
