Year 10 German Curriculum Overview

Rationale for year group & skills: German students will undertake 5 lessons per fortnight. They will study the topics of school, free-time, music, film and media, festivals, family and equality, health, food and sports, home, transport and shopping. We aim to make language learning a positive and rewarding experience, relevant to the needs of our students. We are committed to providing an outstanding learning experience for our young learners so that they feel the same passion for foreign languages. We hope that our students become independent, self-motivated learners who read and listen to German for pleasure.

Autumn Term	Knowledge: Students will study the school topic: talk about their timetables, school uniforms, school rules and special events at school. They will describe school life in both present and past tense. Students will be encouraged to provide reasons for opinions given and use adjectives with nouns. They will revise modal verbs and word order rules. Wider experiences:

Students will gain a better understanding of the German school system and the main differences between British and German schools.

Topic 2: Free-time and media

Knowledge:

Students will study the topic of free-time, discuss how they spend time online, express advantages and disadvantages of life online, learn how to invite people out and buy tickets, express preferences about film and TV shows as well as use the future tense to describe plans for the weekend. They will learn frequency phrases and sequencers with the correct word order, use separable verbs in the present tense and learn how to ask questions. Students will also use the imperfect and perfect (past) tenses together.

Skills:

Students will develop opinion phrases and reasons why in written work and they will practise the skills required for the role-play section of the speaking exam. Students will reinforce listening and reading techniques.

Skills for Assessment Listening and writing Assessment

The listening tasks test the understanding of short extracts and the understanding of main points and details of longer extracts in the context of the free-time and media topic.

The writing assessment will test the skill of writing 80-90 words on the topic of free-time. Students will need to answer all four bullet points. Some students will also translate a paragraph from English into German.

Topic 4: Sport and healthy living

Knowledge:

Students will learn about food and drink in Germany and practise a role play in a restaurant. They will talk about accidents and illnesses, good and bad habits, general wellbeing and what is important. Students will revisit the comparative and develop their understanding of the superlative. Skills:

Students will develop the skills of listening and reading. They will focus on answering questions in English. They will concentrate on the key idea in each question and find the

Skills for Assessment Listening and writing Assessment

The listening tasks test the understanding of short extracts and the understanding of main points and details of longer extracts in the context of the sport and healthy living topic.

The writing assessment will address four bullet points in a 130-150 word task. They will demonstrate that they are confident with three time frames and gain marks for showing knowledge of more complex structures.

Wider experiences:

Students will learn key facts about Germanspeaking countries and towns. and the understanding of main points and details of longer extracts. Students will also complete a translation from German into English.

At Foundation tier, the writing tasks test the ability to write four sentences about a picture, an open response to a 40-50 word task, an open response to an 80-90 word informal task and a translation of five sentences from English into German.

At Higher tier, the writing tasks test the ability to write an open response to an 80-90 word informal task, an open response to a 130-150 word formal task and a translation from English into German of a short paragraph of approximately 50 words.

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
