As you may be aware Government, over the Christmas break, revised guidance for educational settings around the use of face coverings, vaccinations, lateral flow testing and self-isolation for January. Students will be given an updated presentation in tutor time this week to support their return and help understand any changes required.

In brief, I have highlighted the main changes below with immediate effect.

- Students will be required, unless exempt, to wear face coverings in classrooms as well as all indoor communal areas. Please ensure your child has a supply of face coverings, we will provide them if necessary.
- Updated vaccination advice [Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation \(JCVI\)](#)
- The 10 day self-isolation period for people who record a positive test result for Covid -19 has been reduced to 7 days, in most circumstances, on the proviso of a negative LFT result on day 6 and 7 which are taken 24 hours apart.

- Students are strongly encouraged to complete an onsite lateral flow test before return, even if someone has tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 90 days. We will continue to provide all students with lateral flow tests to complete twice weekly testing at home and to [report all results to NHS Test and Trace](#) as we progress through the term.
- Close contact tracing will still continue to be undertaken by NHS Test and Trace and advice, if given, followed.

This is the most up to date guidance however we are aware that there will be an update from the Prime Minister at 5pm this evening.

We are still planning to hold face-to-face parents' evenings at school of students in Years 7 and 9 this term, subject to change. Please refer to previous communications sent to each year group for booking information.
