We are absolutely delighted by the incredibly positive start that Year 7 have made to North Leamington School. It was a real pleasure to see them looking so smart in their new uniform, and we very much appreciate the parent/carer support with this. Last week, over 170 students took part in our *"Getting to Know You"* sessions. Year 7 Information Evening

We would like to invite you and your child to the Year 7 Information Evening on **Monday 14 September**. During the evening parents and carers will meet their child's Form Tutor and receive key information from both the Form Tutor and Senior Leaders.

This is an opportunity for parents and carers to receive information about how we can work together towards the best success of our young people.

You are invited to attend a formal presentation that will start at 4.45. This will be followed by a Tutor presentation at 5.25 which will last around 20 minutes.

A Marketplace will be available throughout the evening from 4.00pm through to 6.30pm with a small number of tables led by key members of our support staff and will be an opportunity to gain

information and ask additional questions to support your child's well-being and progress outside of the classroom. These include:

- Digital Literacy
- Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Timetables: All students have received their timetables both through Go4Schools, and an ID card which shows with a printed copy of their timetable. Please remind your child to keep this safe; lost ID cards will be available at a cost through Parent Pay.

Start of the day: A reminder that lesson 1 starts at 08:45 therefore students must be on site by 08:40 at the latest in order to ensure that they are on time. Year 7 should be entering and exiting via the Lillington Road gate.

Year 7 Trip to the Botanical Gardens: This trip is a great opportunity for students and is scheduled to take place during the week commencing 5th October. A letter with all the details has also been sent today. Students will get the opportunity to experience Animal Handling and a Rainforest Challenge.

Race for Life: Finally, we have a major event upcoming later this month that we are very excited about, and I know Year 7 will be too. On Friday 25 September, we are supporting the Cancer Research UK Race for Life through our annual whole school event (weather permitting). Starting in Tutor Time, students will have the opportunity to run or walk a marked-out route of our school field. Students can come into school in their NLS PE kit and NLS blazer and can wear a pink item of clothing and/or accessory. All students and staff are encouraged to donate £1, either in cash or via ParentPay
