Iceland trip - 10 to 14 April 2025

Thank you for all the deposits paid to secure a place for your child on the Iceland Trip next April. Flights have now been booked with Jet2. Here are the current flight details, these may be subject to change nearer the time and we will keep you updated.

We will be travelling to the airport by coach from NLS. To ensure we have sufficient time to check in and for passport control we will leave school at 5.00am and expect to arrive at Birmingham airport for 5.45am. Hopefully the current redevelopment of the airport should be nearly completed by then. If not, the three hour arrival before the flight gives time to negotiate the check-in procedure.

Just a quick reminder the total cost of the trip is £1250, to be paid in instalments. With the first two dates having passed the remaining instalment dates are as follows:

- Friday 9 August 2024
- Friday 11 October 2024
- Friday 10 January 2025

As we approach the busy time of year for the passport office can you please check your child's passport as **students will need their own passport and have an 'expiry date' at least three months after the 14 April 2025, this is our date of return to the UK. If they do not have a UK passport you will need to apply for the relevant Visa to visit Iceland.** We have been informed that if this is not in place the passport control in Iceland may refuse entry.

We will be arranging a parent/ carer and student meeting on 12 February 2025 at 5.00pm in the school library, rather than in the Autumn term, as originally suggested. Further details will be sent nearer the time.

Can I suggest at this point you consider the advice of previous travellers as when we travel to Iceland in April the weather will be cold and to have clothing suitable for winter conditions including waterproofs.
