Dear Parents and Carers of Year 13

I hope you are well and are looking forward to a good Easter Break. I also hope that the information below around Year 13 Prom and processes for your child's last few days at NLS prove of use.

### **Year 13 Prom "Soft Launch" – Tickets, Medicines, Guidance**

As you know from previous, we have booked the Chesford Grange, Leamington Spa. This is on Wednesday 1 July. Students can arrive from 18:30 for a 19:00 start with food at 19:30. The evening ends at 23:00.

Parents/Carers will need to ensure they pass on all medicines (prescription or over-the-counter ones) with a copy of the Parental Agreement (consent) form found on page 7. Just a reminder that no partners or friends can attend – only existing Year 13 NLS students. If you can please reiterate this to your child. It has not been necessary to do this in the past but perhaps best to flag!

### **Exam Leave**

Friday 8 May marks the final day before Exam Leave for Year 13 – though please be aware of the caveats to this. For example, BTEC students will need to remain available until their teachers indicate otherwise. Also, we will be making direct contact with those for whom we feel on-going school contact would be of real benefit.

Any student can come in to access their subject teachers in their regular timetabled lesson slots. Likewise, any student can come in to access pastoral support from tutors (during timetabled Tutor Time) or the Sixth Form team (any time).

We would also urge parents to continue to actively discuss revision strategies with their children: *where is best to study, how is best to study, when is best to study.*

### **Results Day Year 13**

A reminder that results day for Year 13 is on Thursday 13 August. Results are available between 9am and 10am. Students must collect their own results and, for any students not able to attend, results will be e-mailed to their school e-mail address later that day.
