This letter contains some key reminders as well as pointers for things you need to be aware of.

## **1. UCAS – Very Imminent Deadlines (Y13) and Early Starters (Y12)**

Nearly every Year 13 student has now completed a UCAS application– which is great. We have contacted the parents of those who are yet to as well as students – we do not compel an application, of course, and will defer to the student’s personal preference but we believe it is good to have it as an option as minds do get changed.

The external, UCAS deadline for equal consideration is 14 January.

## **2. World Class Basics**

Just a gentle reminder for parents to please continue to support us in ensuring students adhere to the World Class Basics: on punctuality, attendance, Dress Code and device usage.

## **3. Upcoming Events**

Please refer to recent communications (e.g. Parent Bulletin just before Christmas) for a reminder of upcoming events but please be especially mindful of the fact that there are Mock Exams for both Year 12 and Year 13 at the start of February. Below is the timetable – students will get their personalised schedules in good time.

Can parents please ensure their children adhere to the examination expectations – we do give students clear guidance (various communications we give in advance, posters, assemblies) but a tiny minority still fail to do as required. This runs the risk of their being removed from an examination and having their script failed. This includes infringements such as:

- Taking in water bottles which are non-sports cap and/or which have labels on
- Talking or communicating in the examination space
- Having banned materials on their person


