### Exam Leave Date and Leaving Celebrations – including Yearbook

Exam Leave for Year 13 will be Friday 9 May and the day will follow this basic outline:

- Normal lessons P1 & P2
- P3, P4, Tutor Time = celebrations

The Year 13 Yearbooks are available to pre-order via parentpay ( [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com)). Whilst the deadline has passed we are extending the opportunity to buy a Yearbook to next Friday 4 April.

Ordinarily, teaching staff will be available in the usual timetabled lesson times until the last exam in their subject. Tutors for Year 13 remain available for pastoral support at Tutor Time until the very last examination.

Students can at their discretion come on to the school site after Exam Leave to access this support – though we do actively encourage some students to come if they have been below target. Students will need to still meet Dress Code and will need to adhere to the signing in and out process (details to follow) in order to meet safeguarding needs.

A reminder that Year 13 Prom is Chesford Grange: Monday 30 June with details to follow. This is open only to existing Year 13 students – not partners etc. Again, please prompt your children to be proactive in buying tickets when this is launched.

Please recall that students need to be available for any Exam Contingency Days – so ideally until July 1 if they are to be involved in all the celebrations and the examination requirements.
