Dear parents of Ski Trip 2026 Students

Please be aware that I have organised a Ski Trip 2026 Evening for Tuesday, November 25 from 18:00-19:00 in the Library.

This will provide:

1. An opportunity to meet others going (or whose children are going) on the trip
2. Information on the trip itself with a presentation from me - and which will last about 25-30 minutes
3. A brief 10-15 minute talk on the sorts of items your child may need for the trip - beyond the skis, boots, helmets and poles included in the trip cost

Please be aware also that:

- Our flight details have been confirmed and we will depart very early on Saturday, March 28
- We will return the following Saturday
- Your child will need an in-date EHIC or GHIC card – we will discuss on the 25th but you can simply Google this and be aware that there is no need to pay for a service to secure these
- Insurance details will shortly be shared – please ensure you are satisfied with arrangements and supplement with personal insurance if you feel the need (though coverage provided with the trip has historically been sufficient to meet needs)
- Your child will need their own passport well within date
- Any passport which is not British/E.U. will require you to investigate any Visa implications
- From October 2025, entering some Schengen Accord countries will require individuals to submit to biometric identification
