Revision after school sessions

An after school subject revision timetable will be created and available on the website by the end of January. This formally starts where each night Monday to Friday you will know which subjects are offering revision sessions for your child to attend. These sessions will commence the first week before February Half Term. Please encourage your child to attend as many as possible. Our Year 11 reward scheme called 'Passport to the Prom' will run simultaneously to this where students can stamp a Passport and get rewards for attendance in the shape of free photographs at the Prom. On some of these evenings we will be doing 'Pizza nights' as a thank you to our students.

Independent Advice and Guidance - Careers Interviews:

103 Year 11 students have now had the opportunity to have a 1:1 careers interview with a Careers Adviser. This is a great opportunity to receive independent advice on the options open to students based on their aspirations, skills, and abilities. Action plans will be e-mailed to parents over the coming weeks, for those who have not yet received them, and those that are currently taking place.

A reminder it is a legal requirement that students undertake one of the following until they are 18:

- stay in full-time education, for example Sixth Form or a College
- start an <u>apprenticeship</u> or <u>traineeship</u> (these links will take you to the Government websites where you can find more information.)
- spend 20 hours or more a week working or volunteering, while in part-time education or training
