Dear Parents and Carers,

Warm Weather Arrangements

I am writing to inform you that we are making further adjustments to our uniform expectations for the remainder of this week in light of the anticipated increase in warm weather conditions and the current extreme high temperature warning.

For the remainder of this week, students will be permitted to wear their school PE kit as an alternative to their normal school uniform. This is entirely optional, and students may choose whichever option they feel most comfortable wearing.

Students who choose to wear their school uniform should continue to follow the guidance communicated on Monday, including the previously agreed adjustments. However, if students feel more comfortable wearing their school PE kit during the warmer conditions, they are welcome to do so for the rest of the week.

We recognise that a number of parents and carers have raised concerns regarding the forecasted temperatures. Please be assured that the welfare and wellbeing of our students will always be our primary consideration. We are fortunate to be in the unique position of having a state-of-the-art school building with a climate-controlled environment, enabling students to continue learning safely and comfortably throughout the day.

As you will be aware, students were informed during Tutor Time on Monday of a number of adaptations that had already been put in place. A further Tutor Time notice will be shared with students today outlining these additional uniform arrangements.

For parents' awareness, the school had already implemented a number of adapted measures to support students during the warmer weather:

- Curriculum areas, including PE and Food, have made adaptations to ensure activities can be delivered safely.
- There have been minor revisions to the Progression Examinations timetable. Further information can be found here: [Progression Exam Timetable on NLS Website](#)
- Celebration Evening has been postponed and will now take place on **30 June**.
- All PE extra-curricular activities have been cancelled for the remainder of the week.
- Students will not be permitted to use the Astro or MUGA during break and lunchtime for the remainder of the week (Wednesday to Friday).

Students have also been reminded about sensible precautions to take during periods of hot weather, including:

- Bringing a water bottle to school each day.
- Applying sun cream before attending school.
- Wearing a hat when travelling to and from school if appropriate.

- Remaining in shaded areas during social times wherever possible.

The heat is expected to decrease over the weekend, therefore we anticipate returning to our usual uniform expectations from Monday. As we have done this week we will continue to monitor weather conditions closely, keeping this under review and will update you of any further adjustments necessary to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff.
