Dear Parents, Carers

I hope you are well.

This letter contains some key reminders as well as pointers for things you need to be aware of.

1. Future Pathways Launch

This full day event takes place on Wednesday, June 17. It is an opportunity to understand what post-18 options are available to your children. It is generic in places but also specific and personalised – with, for example, sessions tailored to high demand subjects and organisations. It also covers literacy support in order to write strong applications to whatever next step destination your child is targeting.

2. Work Experience

We are now at a crucial phase with this. It's great so many students have sorted their placements and used Grofar (the online platform for careers) to record the details. For those who are yet to secure a place, and even though the student needs to drive this, we will this week be looking at a last supportive effort to help secure everyone a quality placement. Please continue to speak with your child around this and do what you can to support.

Once a student has a placement sorted that is recorded in Grofar, parents are asked via an automated email to give their consent. If all parents can please respond to this as the placement is not complete without this – thanks to those who have.

These work experiences can be really important to the applications which the Future Pathways Launch flags.

3. World Class Basics

Just a gentle reminder for parents to please continue to support us in ensuring students adhere to the World Class Basics: on punctuality, attendance, Dress Code and device usage.

Also, please do all you can to ensure your child is on the school site by 08:40 each day.

4. Upcoming Events

Please refer to recent communications for a reminder of upcoming events but please be especially mindful of the fact that there are Progression Exams for Year

12 at the end of June. Below is the timetable – students will get their personalised schedules in good time.

Can parents please ensure their children adhere to the examination expectations – we do give students clear guidance (various communications we give in advance, posters, assemblies) but a tiny minority still fail to do as required. This runs the risk of their being removed from an examination and having their script failed. This includes infringements such as:

- Taking in water bottles which are non-sports-cap and/or which have labels on
- Talking or communicating in the examination space
- Having banned materials on their person


