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Dear Parents and Carers,

It was great to see so many parents in attendance with their children at this week's Year 13 Subject Evening. This letter primarily is to highlight some key points of contact and reference for you in light of feedback from the questionnaires completed. Where the response was overwhelmingly positive (for which, many thanks), there were three key areas where some parents felt provision might be enhanced:

- 1. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year
- 2. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at NLS



This provision very much complements the Tutor Time curriculum.

We recognise that for students to be academically successful they need to feel safe, happy and confident.

2. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at NLS

Our curriculum is recognised as being rich and diverse as well as broad and balanced and we are proud of how our timetable blocking is constructed around the indicative preferences of students – preferences identified in the Sixth Form application process. This year, we anticipate a terrific 96% of students' indicative preferences being met by the timetable we are implementing – a rise on last year's















93% success rate. That said, we are always looking to enhance provision and have recently introduced Politics, Dance and Product Design. Each year, we look at staffing potential as well as gauge student interest and seek, where possible, to accommodate personalised interests and to introduce new courses.

3. My child can take part in clubs and activities at NLS.

We have a very popular Enrichment Programme in place – on Wednesdays, Period 5 – where we offer a range of opportunities, some of which are self-directed and many of which are teacher-led. The initial offer in Term 1 was as follows:
