GCSE/A-Level Drama Theatre Visit

The Drama Department has organised a theatre visit to see the performance of Life of Pi for Y10 and Y12 at The Curve Theatre on Tuesday 12 March 2024. This trip will prepare students for their GCSE/A-Level Component 3 Theatre Makers in Practice examination which is worth 40% of their GCSE and A-Level, consequently we strongly advise that they attend.

Puppetry, magic and storytelling combine in a unique, Olivier Award-winning stage adaptation of the best-selling novel. After a cargo ship sinks in the middle of the vast Pacific Ocean, a 16-year-old boy named Pi is stranded on a lifeboat with four other survivors — a hyena, a zebra, an orangutan and a Royal Bengal tiger. The coach will depart from NLS at 17:30 promptly and we hope to return by 22:20 approximately. Students can wear their own clothes for this theatre visit provided they are appropriate for a theatre visit. Students will need to make the necessary arrangements to be collected from school.
