Dear Parent/ Carer

Year 13 Sociology Warwickshire Justice Centre visit – November and December 2025.

We are delighted to offer Sociology students the opportunity to attend the Warwickshire Justice Centre in Leamington Spa. The visit will involve a tour of the Justice Centre, meeting with a judge and sitting in on crown and/or magistrates trials and sentencing. This will supplement their studies on Paper 3 – Crime and Deviance, punishment, patterns of crime and victims as well as overarching theories within Sociology. Students will be split into three equal sized groups to meet the Court's stipulation of maximum numbers and the visit will either be on **Tuesday 11 November, Tuesday 25 November or Tuesday 2 December 2025**. The groupings are on ParentPay and will be shared with the students in class in advance.

The visit to the court itself is free but, as we will be out over lunchtime, students will need to bring a packed lunch and water for themselves or bring sufficient money to purchase food locally to the court on the day.

As the students are effectively members of the public attending the courthouse to observe in the public gallery, students should be advised that their bags may be searched as they enter the Justice Centre and any deodorant or perfume will need to be handed in at reception. Students may bring water/something to drink, but will be required to take a sip of it as they enter. Mobile phones should be switched off while they are in the courtroom. Students will receive further detailed instructions relating to their expected conduct in the courtroom on the day. One specific request from the Justice Centre is to ensure appropriate clothing is worn. This is in line with our own dress code policy, but students should be reminded of this in advance. This is to uphold the integrity of the court.

It is advisable that students do not take valuables on this trip. However, if it is necessary, please ensure that your own insurance covers such items.

Please complete the consent details for the date your child has been allocated to on ParentPay (www.parentpay.com) by Friday 24 October 2025 at the latest.

Students may meet us at the Court (Newbold Terrace, Leamington Spa, CV32 4EL) and leave from court at the end of the day but consent for this must also be given via ParentPay before Friday 24 October. Students will not be allowed to arrive or leave independently if written consent is not received by this time. Ms Holland and Miss Howard will be accompanying any students leaving from school and they will be expected at school at the usual time of 8.30am. We will walk to the Justice Centre from school at 8.45am.

Parents/Carers will need to ensure they pass on all medicines (prescription or over-the-counter ones) with a copy of the Parental Agreement (consent) form found on page 7. Educational site visits are an additional opportunity for students to support their learning. Should we have any concerns regarding a student's behaviour prior to the trip, that student will be withdrawn from the trip and individual parents will be notified accordingly.
