## **Careers: Year 11 September Offer**

Year 11 Students have been set as a Homework on Go 4 Schools (G4S) a short MS form to complete regarding the offer they have received for their next step post GCSE/ Btec exams. It is a statutory requirement that we collate the *Year 11 September Offer* information by the Department of Education. The offer a student has received may be dependent on students achieving certain grades or it may be an unconditional offer. All Year 11 students are asked to complete the form as soon as they receive an offer for their next step after GCSEs, whether the offer is conditional or unconditional, and particularly those who are not intending to attend NLS Sixth Form in September or please see Mrs Barley-Morey.

Students with multiple offers only need to report one offer— ideally the offer they are most likely to accept. They do not need to update the form if they later change their plans. Students who are undecided about their next steps do not need to complete the form until they have made a decision, which may be after receiving their results in August.

This process allows the school and the Prospects Careers Service to better support any students who may be unsure about their next steps, helping to ensure that every young person moves on to a positive destination.

We would appreciate the support of parents and carers in encouraging their child to complete the form as soon as they receive an offer. The link to the form is here Year 11 September 2025 Offer
