Dear Parents and Carers,

As referenced during the transition process the Maths department have spent the first few weeks of term getting to know our Year 7 students and completing some baseline testing. We have utilised this information alongside the Key Stage 2 results to create some initial teaching groups that are tailored to students' current learning needs.

On Monday 29 September students will arrive to their current groups as normal and their maths teacher will organise them moving to their new groups. During next week students will receive an updated version of their timetable with this information on, and it will be available on Go4Schools from Monday.

We regularly review the groupings in maths, as we develop a broader picture of each student's progress. This means that, as the year goes on, some students may move groups to ensure they are appropriately stretched or supported. Our priority is to make sure every child makes the best possible progress.

Although students are placed into groups, they will all broadly study the same topics, building on knowledge from Key Stage 2. The difference lies in the starting point and level of challenge within each set, ensuring the work is pitched appropriately for every learner.
