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Dear Parents and Carers

Year 7 have really made a fantastic start to life at North Learnington School over the last 3 days. It has been wonderful to see all the smiling faces and positivity they have brought to their first week in school and I really hope all 240 students have enjoyed their experience so far. I would like to take this opportunity to recognise how impressed I have been with their presentation and first interactions with other members of the school community. Uniform has been immaculate and it has been lovely to see how polite, supportive and confident they have been when engaging with others.

You should have also received some individual communication from your child's form tutor this week. They will remain a key point of contact throughout the year and you will get an opportunity to meet with them face to face on our 'Meet the Tutor' Evening on Monday 10th October. More information will follow in the coming weeks with regard to the logistics of the evening.

I would like to also draw your attention to a few key bits of information that will be important in supporting students throughout their journey with us. ParentPay letters have now been sent out to all parent/carers, if you there are any concerns with this please contact our administrative team at school Admin Support <u>adminsupport@northleamington.co.uk</u>. We are also in the process of distributing the final few ID badges to students and this should be completed by early next week. In the short term please be aware that students can still access the canteen at school should they require, they just need to give their name to the canteen staff when purchasing items of food or drink. Any student eligible for free school meals get an allowance of £2.21 which appears on their card each day. The best way to utilise this is to get a meal deal, but it can be spent on anything. At the end of each day anything remaining is wiped and started again the following day. Parents/Carers can add to student cards in the same way as all students via parent pay.

It is also really important all parents and carers have access to our learning platform, Go4Schools (G4S). Throughout the year lots of key information will be available to access, including information on reward points, attendance and ultimately progress at key data points during the year. Ensuring regular high attendance for all students is something we really value and NLS and we recognise the importance of support individual students and families with any challenges that may arise throughout the academic year.
