I hope this communication finds you well. As we move into the second half term of the year, I would like to share a few important bits of information.

Year 11 Subject Evening for Parents and Carers

It is with pleasure that I write to inform you of the arrangements for the Year 11 Subject Evening on Monday 22 November 2021 from 4.30 – 7.15pm.

Following feedback, we are continuing to use the online parents' evening package called School Cloud. This allows you to book appointment times with relevant teachers, which will then take place virtually through the same website.

Appointments can be made from Monday 8 November 4pm and will close on Monday 22 November 9am.

A number of students may have two teachers in some subjects, and where this is the case you will only be able to book one appointment but where possible, both teachers will be present. Students studying triple science will not be able to see teachers from all 3 disciplines, but each teacher will have an overview of information to share.

As this is a subject evening you will be unable to book appointments with your child's Form Tutor due to their subject commitments. If you do wish to speak to them at any point during the year then please contact them directly via email.

In order to take part in appointments you will need to refer to the [Parent Guide for Video Appointments](#). The School Cloud system controls the length of each appointment, which will be restricted to 5 minutes. This is the usual length of an NLS subject evening appointment however, if you have any specific questions; please raise these at the start of the appointment to ensure you do not run out of time for these to be answered.

The most recent attainment and engagement data will be available via Go4Schools in advance of the evening and we would encourage you to revisit this prior to the appointment and to be ready to ask any specific questions you have.

Final Exam Dates

Whilst we are still awaiting an actual exam timetable of subjects, we have now been given information on when the final exam dates will be for this academic year. These are the final dates that exams will run until and may prove useful in terms of booking holidays etc. for later in the year.

Students must remain available for exams until after the contingency date has passed. Also a reminder that the Year 11 prom will be occurring at the end of this week (Friday 1 July 2022)

The last exam date is 28 June 2022- this is the day of the final exam in usual circumstances.

The exam contingency date is 29 June 2022- this date is when any exam would be moved to, that is unable to take place on the calendared date. Most likely reasons are national days of mourning, disaster etc. so not an impossibility.

Revision Week and Mock results

Students have just completed their first focused revision week in school with activities completed throughout the week during tutor time. It has been very pleasing to see the focus of students and bodes well moving forward for the rest of the year. In addition, students will be receiving their English and Maths Mock results during lessons next week and need to continue to respond positively to the advice given regarding the areas of improvement and knowledge gaps.

Please note there will be another English and Maths Mock Week in February.

Next Mock Examination Window

The second mock examination window will start on Monday 6 December and run for 2 weeks. We are currently putting together the timetable and logistics of how they will be organised. Further details will be shared in assembly with students very soon and communication with parents will come through the usual bulletin.
